Commandments Scripture

Genesis 26:5 - Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my **commandments**, my statutes, and my laws.

Exodus 15:26 - And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his **commandments**, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

Exodus 16:28 - And the LORD said unto Moses, How long refuse ye to keep my **commandments** and my laws?

Exodus 20:6 - And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my **commandments**.

Exodus 24:12 - And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and **commandments** which I have written; that thou mayest teach them.

Exodus 34:28 - And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten **commandments**.

Leviticus 4:2 - Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul shall sin through ignorance against any of the **commandments** of the LORD *concerning things* which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them:

Leviticus 4:13 - And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done *somewhat against* any of the **commandments** of the LORD *concerning things* which should not be done, and are guilty;

Leviticus 4:22 - When a ruler hath sinned, and done *somewhat* through ignorance *against* any of the **commandments** of the LORD his God *concerning things* which should not be done, and is guilty;

Leviticus 4:27 - And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth *somewhat against* any of the **commandments** of the LORD *concerning things* which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

Leviticus 5:17 - And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the **commandments** of the LORD; though he wist *it* not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.

Leviticus 22:31 - Therefore shall ye keep my **commandments**, and do them: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 26:3 - If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my **commandments**, and do them;

Leviticus 26:14 - But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these **commandments**;

Leviticus 26:15 - And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my **commandments**, *but* that ye break my covenant:

Leviticus 27:34 - These *are* the **commandments**, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount Sinai.

Numbers 15:22 - And if ye have erred, and not observed all these **commandments**, which the LORD hath spoken unto Moses,

Numbers 15:39 - And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the **commandments** of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

Numbers 15:40 - That ye may remember, and do all my **commandments**, and be holy unto your God.

Numbers 36:13 - These *are* the **commandments** and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.

Deuteronomy 4:2 - Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish *ought* from it, that ye may keep the **commandments** of the LORD your God which I command you.

Deuteronomy 4:13 - And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, *even* ten **commandments**; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.

Deuteronomy 4:40 - Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his **commandments**, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong *thy* days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.

Deuteronomy 5:10 - And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my **commandments**.

Deuteronomy 5:29 - O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my **commandments** always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!

Deuteronomy 5:31 - But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the **commandments**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

Deuteronomy 6:1 - Now these *are* the **commandments**, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

Deuteronomy 6:2 - That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his **commandments**, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

Deuteronomy 6:17 - Ye shall diligently keep the **commandments** of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee.

Deuteronomy 6:25 - And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these **commandments** before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.

Deuteronomy 7:9 - Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his **commandments** to a thousand generations;

Deuteronomy 7:11 - Thou shalt therefore keep the **commandments**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

Deuteronomy 8:1 - All the **commandments** which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 8:2 - And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove thee, to know what *was* in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his **commandments**, or no.

Deuteronomy 8:6 - Therefore thou shalt keep the **commandments** of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.

Deuteronomy 8:11 - Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his **commandments**, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

Deuteronomy 10:4 - And he wrote on the tables, according to the first writing, the ten **commandments**, which the LORD spake unto you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly: and the LORD gave them unto me.

Deuteronomy 10:13 - To keep the **commandments** of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

Deuteronomy 11:1 - Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his **commandments**, *always*.

Deuteronomy 11:8

Therefore shall ye keep all the **commandments** which I command you this day, that ye may

be strong, and go in and possess the land, whither ye go to possess it;

Deuteronomy 11:13 - And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my **commandments** which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy 11:22 - For if ye shall diligently keep all these **commandments** which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him;

Deuteronomy 11:27 - A blessing, if ye obey the **commandments** of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:

Deuteronomy 11:28 - And a curse, if ye will not obey the **commandments** of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

Deuteronomy 13:4 - Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his **commandments**, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him.

Deuteronomy 13:18 - When thou shalt hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep all his **commandments** which I command thee this day, to do *that which is* right in the eyes of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 15:5 - Only if thou carefully hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all these **commandments** which I command thee this day.

Deuteronomy 19:9 - If thou shalt keep all these **commandments** to do them, which I command thee this day, to love the LORD thy God, and to walk ever in his ways; then shalt thou add three cities more for thee, beside these three:

Deuteronomy 26:13 - Then thou shalt say before the LORD thy God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of *mine* house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all thy **commandments** which thou hast commanded me: I have not transgressed thy **commandments**, neither have I forgotten *them*:

Deuteronomy 26:17 - Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his **commandments**, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:

Deuteronomy 26:18 - And the LORD hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people, as he hath promised thee, and that *thou* shouldst keep all his **commandments**;

Deuteronomy 27:1 - And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the **commandments** which I command you this day.

Deuteronomy 27:10 - Thou shalt therefore obey the voice of the LORD thy God, and do his **commandments** and his statutes, which I command thee this day.

Deuteronomy 28:1 - And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his **commandments** which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

Deuteronomy 28:9 - The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the **commandments** of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

Deuteronomy 28:13 - And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the **commandments** of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do *them*:

Deuteronomy 28:15 - But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his **commandments** and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Deuteronomy 28:45 - Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his **commandments** and his statutes which he commanded thee:

Deuteronomy 30:8 - And thou shalt return and obey the voice of the LORD, and do all his **commandments** which I command thee this day.

Deuteronomy 30:10 - If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his **commandments** and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, *and* if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

Deuteronomy 30:16 - In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his **commandments** and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deuteronomy 31:5 - And the LORD shall give them up before your face, that ye may do unto them according unto all the **commandments** which I have commanded you.

Joshua 22:5 - But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his **commandments**, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Judges 2:17 - And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which

their fathers walked in, obeying the **commandments** of the LORD; *but* they did not so.

Judges 3:4 - And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the **commandments** of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

1 Samuel 15:11 - It repenteth me that I have set up Saul *to be* king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my **commandments**. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

1 Kings 2:3 - And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his **commandments**, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

1 Kings 3:14 - And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my **commandments**, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

1 Kings 6:12 - *Concerning* this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my **commandments** to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

1 Kings 8:58 - That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his **commandments**, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.

1 Kings 8:61 - Let your heart therefore be perfect with the LORD our God, to walk in his statutes, and to keep his **commandments**, as at this day.

1 Kings 9:6 - *But* if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your children, and will not keep my **commandments** *and* my statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them:

1 Kings 11:34 - Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my **commandments** and my statutes:

1 Kings 11:38 - And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do *that is* right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my **commandments**, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

1 Kings 14:8 - And rent the kingdom away from the house of David, and gave it thee: and yet thou hast not been as my servant David, who kept my **commandments**, and who followed me with all his heart, to do *that only which* was right in mine eyes;

1 Kings 18:18 - And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the **commandments** of the LORD, and thou hast followed Baalim.

2 Kings 17:13 - Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, *and by* all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my **commandments** *and* my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

2 Kings 17:16 - And they left all the **commandments** of the LORD their God, and made them molten images, *even* two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal.

2 Kings 17:19 - Also Judah kept not the **commandments** of the LORD their God, but walked in the statutes of Israel which they made.

2 Kings 18:6 - For he clave to the LORD, *and* departed not from following him, but kept his **commandments**, which the LORD commanded Moses.

2 Kings 23:3 - And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his **commandments** and his testimonies and his statutes with all *their* heart and all *their* soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

1 Chronicles 28:7 - Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my **commandments** and my judgments, as at this day.

1 Chronicles 28:8 - Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the **commandments** of the LORD your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave *it* for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.

1 Chronicles 29:19 - And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy **commandments**, thy testimonies, and thy statutes, and to do all *these things*, and to build the palace, *for* the which I have made provision.

2 Chronicles 7:19 - But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my **commandments**, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them;

2 Chronicles 17:4 - But sought to the *LORD* God of his father, and walked in his **commandments**, and not after the doings of Israel.

2 Chronicles 24:20 - And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the **commandments** of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.

2 Chronicles 31:21 - And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the **commandments**, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart, and prospered.

2 Chronicles 34:31 - And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his **commandments**, and his testimonies, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

Ezra 7:11 - Now this *is* the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, *even* a scribe of the words of the **commandments** of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.

Ezra 9:10 - And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? for we have forsaken thy **commandments**,

Ezra 9:14 - Should we again break thy **commandments**, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? wouldest not thou be angry with us till thou hadst consumed *us*, so that *there should be* no remnant nor escaping?

Nehemiah 1:5 - And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his **commandments**:

Nehemiah 1:7 - We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the **commandments**, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

Nehemiah 1:9 - But *if* ye turn unto me, and keep my **commandments**, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, *yet* will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.

Nehemiah 9:13 - Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and **commandments**:

Nehemiah 9:16 - But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy **commandments**,

Nehemiah 9:29 - And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy **commandments**, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

Nehemiah 9:34 - Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy **commandments** and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them.

Nehemiah 10:29 - They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the **commandments** of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his

statutes;

Psalm 78:7 - That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his **commandments**:

Psalm 89:31 - If they break my statutes, and keep not my **commandments**;

Psalm 103:18 - To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his **commandments** to do them.

Psalm 103:20 - Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his **commandments**, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

Psalm 111:7 - The works of his hands *are* verity and judgment; all his **commandments** *are* sure.

Psalm 111:10 - The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *his* **commandments**: his praise endureth for ever.

Psalm 112:1 - Praise ye the LORD. Blessed *is* the man *that* feareth the LORD, *that* delighteth greatly in his **commandments**.

Psalm 119:6 - Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:10 - With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:19 - I *am* a stranger in the earth: hide not thy **commandments** from me.

Psalm 119:21 - Thou hast rebuked the proud *that are* cursed, which do err from thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:32 - I will run the way of thy **commandments**, when thou shalt enlarge my heart.

Psalm 119:35 - Make me to go in the path of thy **commandments**; for therein do I delight.

Psalm 119:47 - And I will delight myself in thy **commandments**, which I have loved.

Psalm 119:48 - My hands also will I lift up unto thy **commandments**, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

Psalm 119:60 - I made haste, and delayed not to keep thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:66 - Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:73 - Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:86 - All thy **commandments** *are* faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me.

Psalm 119:98 - Thou through thy **commandments** hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they *are* ever with me.

Psalm 119:115 - Depart from me, ye evildoers: for I will keep the **commandments** of my God.

Psalm 119:127 - Therefore I love thy **commandments** above gold; yea, above fine gold.

Psalm 119:131 - I opened my mouth, and panted: for I longed for thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:143 - Trouble and anguish have taken hold on me: *yet* thy **commandments** *are* my delights.

Psalm 119:151 - Thou *art* near, O LORD; and all thy **commandments** *are* truth.

Psalm 119:166 - LORD, I have hoped for thy salvation, and done thy **commandments**.

Psalm 119:172 - My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy **commandments** *are* righteousness.

Psalm 119:176 - I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy **commandments**.

Proverbs 2:1 - My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my **commandments** with thee;

Proverbs 3:1 - My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my **commandments**:

Proverbs 4:4 - He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my **commandments**, and live.

Proverbs 7:1 - My son, keep my words, and lay up my **commandments** with thee.

Proverbs 7:2 - Keep my **commandments**, and live; and my law as the apple of thine eye.

Proverbs 10:8 - The wise in heart will receive **commandments**: but a prating fool shall fall.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 - Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his **commandments**: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man.

Isaiah 48:18 - O that thou hadst hearkened to my **commandments**! then had thy peace been

as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea:

Daniel 9:4 - And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his **commandments**;

Amos 2:4 - Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away *the punishment* thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept his **commandments**, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked:

Matthew 5:19 - Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least **commandments**, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 15:9 - But in vain they do worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the **commandments** of men.

Matthew 19:17 - And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is* none good but one, *that is*, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the **commandments**.

Matthew 22:40 - On these two **commandments** hang all the law and the prophets.

Mark 7:7 - Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the **commandments** of men.

Mark 10:19 - Thou knowest the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

Mark 12:29 - And Jesus answered him, The first of all the **commandments is**, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Luke 1:6 - And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the **commandments** and ordinances of the Lord blameless.

Luke 18:20 - Thou knowest the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.

John 14:15 - If ye love me, keep my **commandments**.

John 14:21 - He that hath my **commandments**, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

John 15:10 - If ye keep my **commandments**, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's **commandments**, and abide in his love.

Acts 1:2 - Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given **commandments** unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

1 Corinthians 7:19 - Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the **commandments** of God.

1 Corinthians 14:37 - If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the **commandments** of the Lord.

Ephesians 2:15 - Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even* the law of **commandments contained** in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

Colossians 2:22 - Which all are to perish with the using;) after the **commandments** and doctrines of men?

Colossians 4:10 - Aristarchus my fellow prisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, (touching whom ye received **commandments**: if he come unto you, receive him;)

1 Thessalonians 4:2 - For ye know what **commandments** we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

Titus 1:14 - Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and **commandments** of men, that turn from the truth.

1 John 2:3 - And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his **commandments**.

1 John 2:4 - He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his **commandments**, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

1 John 3:22 - And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his **commandments**, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

1 John 3:24 - And he that keepeth his **commandments** dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

1 John 5:2 - By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his **commandments**.

1 John 5:3 - For this is the love of God, that we keep his **commandments**: and his **commandments** are not grievous.

2 John 1:6 - And this is love, that we walk after his **commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Revelation 12:17 - And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the **commandments** of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 14:12 - Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the **commandments** of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Revelation 22:14 - Blessed *are* they that do his **commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Consecrate Scripture

Exodus 28:3 - And thou shalt speak unto all *that are* wise hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to **consecrate** him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 28:41 - And thou shalt put them upon Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him; and shalt anoint them, and **consecrate** them, and sanctify them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 29:9 - And thou shalt gird them with girdles, Aaron and his sons, and put the bonnets on them: and the priest's office shall be theirs for a perpetual statute: and thou shalt **consecrate** Aaron and his sons.

Exodus 29:33 - And they shall eat those things wherewith the atonement was made, to **consecrate** *and* to sanctify them: but a stranger shall not eat *thereof*, because they *are* holy.

Exodus 29:35 - And thus shalt thou do unto Aaron, and to his sons, according to all *things* which I have commanded thee: seven days shalt thou **consecrate** them.

Exodus 30:30 - And thou shalt anoint Aaron and his sons, and **consecrate** them, that *they* may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 32:29 - For Moses had said, **Consecrate** yourselves to day to the LORD, even every man upon his son, and upon his brother; that he may bestow upon you a blessing this day.

Leviticus 8:33 - And ye shall not go out of the door of the tabernacle of the congregation *in* seven days, until the days of your consecration be at an end: for seven days shall he **consecrate** you.

Leviticus 16:32 - And the priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall **consecrate** to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, *even* the holy garments:

Numbers 6:12 - And he shall **consecrate** unto the LORD the days of his separation, and shall bring a lamb of the first year for a trespass offering: but the days that were before shall be lost, because his separation was defiled.

1 Chronicles 29:5 - The gold for *things* of gold, and the silver for *things* of silver, and for all manner of work *to be made* by the hands of artificers. And who *then* is willing to **consecrate** his service this day unto the LORD?

2 Chronicles 13:9 - Have ye not cast out the priests of the LORD, the sons of Aaron, and the Levites, and have made you priests after the manner of the nations of *other* lands? so that whosoever cometh to **consecrate** himself with a young bullock and seven rams, *the same* may be a priest of *them that are* no gods.

Ezekiel 43:26 - Seven days shall they purge the altar and purify it; and they shall **consecrate** themselves.

Micah 4:13 - Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will **consecrate** their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.

Consecration Scripture

Exodus 29:22 - Also thou shalt take of the ram the fat and the rump, and the fat that covereth the inwards, and the caul *above* the liver, and the two kidneys, and the fat that *is* upon them, and the right shoulder; for it *is* a ram of **consecration**:

Exodus 29:26 - And thou shalt take the breast of the ram of Aaron's **consecration**, and wave it *for* a wave offering before the LORD: and it shall be thy part.

Exodus 29:27 - And thou shalt sanctify the breast of the wave offering, and the shoulder of the heave offering, which is waved, and which is heaved up, of the ram of the **consecration**, *even of that which is* for Aaron, and of *that which is* for his sons:

Exodus 29:31 - And thou shalt take the ram of the **consecration**, and seethe his flesh in the holy place.

Leviticus 8:22 - And he brought the other ram, the ram of **consecration**: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram.

Leviticus 8:29 - And Moses took the breast, and waved it *for* a wave offering before the LORD: *for* of the ram of **consecration** it was Moses' part; as the LORD commanded Moses.

Leviticus 8:33 - And ye shall not go out of the door of the tabernacle of the congregation *in* seven days, until the days of your **consecration** be at an end: for seven days shall he consecrate you.

Numbers 6:7 - He shall not make himself unclean for his father, or for his mother, for his brother, or for his sister, when they die: because the **consecration** of his God *is* upon his head.

Numbers 6:9 - And if any man die very suddenly by him, and he hath defiled the head of his **consecration**; then he shall shave his head in the day of his cleansing, on the seventh day shall he shave it.

Convocations

Leviticus 23:2 – Speak **unto the children of Israel**, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy **convocations**, even these are my feasts.

Leviticus 23:4 – There are the feasts of the LORD, even holy **convocations**, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

Leviticus 23:37 – These are the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy **convocations**, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon this day.

Feast Scripture

Genesis 19:3 - And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a **feast**, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

Genesis 21:8 - And the child grew, and was weaned: and Abraham made a great **feast** the *same* day that Isaac was weaned.

Genesis 26:30 - And he made them a **feast**, and they did eat and drink.

Genesis 29:22 - And Laban gathered together all the men of the place, and made a **feast**.

Genesis 40:20 - And it came to pass the third day, *which was* Pharaoh's birthday, that he made a **feast** unto all his servants: and he lifted up the head of the chief butler and of the chief baker among his servants.

Exodus 5:1 - And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a **feast** unto me in the wilderness.

Exodus 10:9 - And Moses said, We will go with our young and with our old, with our sons and with our daughters, with our flocks and with our herds will we go; for we *must hold* a **feast** unto the LORD.

Exodus 12:14 - And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a **feast** to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a **feast** by an ordinance for ever.

Exodus 12:17 - And ye shall observe *the feast* of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

Exodus 13:6 - Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, and in the seventh day *shall be* a **feast** to the LORD.

Exodus 23:14 - Three times thou shalt keep a **feast** unto me in the year.

Exodus 23:15 - Thou shalt keep the **feast** of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:)

Exodus 23:16 - And the **feast** of harvest, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and the **feast** of ingathering, *which is* in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.

Exodus 32:5 - And when Aaron saw *it*, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow *is* a **feast** to the LORD.

Exodus 34:18 - The **feast** of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

Exodus 34:22 - And thou shalt observe the **feast** of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the **feast** of ingathering at the year's end.

Exodus 34:25 - Thou shalt not offer the blood of my sacrifice with leaven; neither shall the sacrifice of the **feast** of the passover be left unto the morning.

Leviticus 23:6 - And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the **feast** of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

Leviticus 23:34 - **Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.**

Leviticus 23:39 - Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a **feast** unto the LORD seven days: on the first day *shall be* a sabbath, and on the eighth day *shall be* a sabbath.

Leviticus 23:41 - And ye shall keep it a **feast** unto the LORD seven days in the year. *It shall be* a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month.

Numbers 28:17 - And in the fifteenth day of this month *is* the **feast**: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten.

Numbers 29:12 - And on the fifteenth day of the seventh month ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work, and ye shall keep a **feast** unto the LORD seven days:

Deuteronomy 16:10 - And thou shalt keep the **feast** of weeks unto the LORD thy God with a tribute of a freewill offering of thine hand, which thou shalt give *unto the LORD thy God*, according as the LORD thy God hath blessed thee:

Deuteronomy 16:13 - Thou shalt observe the **feast** of tabernacles seven days, after that thou hast gathered in thy corn and thy wine:

Deuteronomy 16:14 - And thou shalt rejoice in thy **feast**, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that *are* within thy gates.

Deuteronomy 16:15 - Seven days shalt thou keep a solemn **feast** unto the LORD thy God in the place which the LORD shall choose: because the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thine increase, and in all the works of thine hands, therefore thou shalt surely rejoice.

Deuteronomy 16:16 - Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the **feast** of unleavened bread, and in the **feast** of weeks, and in the **feast** of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

Deuteronomy 31:10 - And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of *every* seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the **feast** of tabernacles,

Judges 14:10 - So his father went down unto the woman: and Samson made there a **feast**; for so used the young men to do.

Judges 14:12 - And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the **feast**, and find *it* out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments:

Judges 14:17 - And she wept before him the seven days, while their **feast** lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.

Judges 21:19 - Then they said, Behold, *there is* a **feast** of the LORD in Shiloh yearly *in a place* which *is* on the north side of Bethel, on the east side of the highway that goeth up from Bethel to Shechem, and on the south of Lebonah.

1 Samuel 25:36 - And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a **feast** in his house, like the **feast** of a king; and Nabal's heart *was* merry within him, for he *was* very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

2 Samuel 3:20 - So Abner came to David to Hebron, and twenty men with him. And David made Abner and the men that *were* with him a **feast**.

1 Kings 3:15 - And Solomon awoke; and, behold, *it was* a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings, and made a **feast** to all his servants.

1 Kings 8:2 - And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the **feast** in the month Ethanim, which *is* the seventh month.

1 Kings 8:65 - And at that time Solomon held a **feast**, and all Israel with him, a great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt, before the LORD our God, seven days and seven days, *even* fourteen days.

1 Kings 12:32 - And Jeroboam ordained a **feast** in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the **feast** that *is* in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, sacrificing unto the calves that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

1 Kings 12:33 - So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, *even* in the month which he had devised of his own heart; and ordained a **feast** unto the children of Israel: and he offered upon the altar, and burnt incense.

2 Chronicles 5:3 - Wherefore all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the king in the **feast** which *was* in the seventh month.

2 Chronicles 7:8 - Also at the same time Solomon kept the **feast** seven days, and all Israel with him, a very great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt.

2 Chronicles 7:9 - And in the eighth day they made a solemn assembly: for they kept the dedication of the altar seven days, and the **feast** seven days.

2 Chronicles 8:13 - Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, *even* in the **feast** of unleavened bread, and in the **feast** of weeks, and in the **feast** of tabernacles.

2 Chronicles 30:13 - And there assembled at Jerusalem much people to keep the **feast** of unleavened bread in the second month, a very great congregation.

2 Chronicles 30:21 - And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the **feast** of unleavened bread seven days with great gladness: and the Levites and the priests praised

the LORD day by day, *singing* with loud instruments unto the LORD.

2 Chronicles 30:22 - And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD: and they did eat throughout the **feast** seven days, offering peace offerings, and making confession to the LORD God of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 35:17 - And the children of Israel that were present kept the passover at that time, and the **feast** of unleavened bread seven days.

Ezra 3:4 - They kept also the **feast** of tabernacles, as *it is* written, and *offered* the daily burnt offerings by number, according to the custom, as the duty of every day required;

Ezra 6:22 - And kept the **feast** of unleavened bread seven days with joy: for the LORD had made them joyful, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.

Nehemiah 8:14 - And they found written in the law which the LORD had commanded by Moses, that the children of Israel should dwell in booths in the **feast** of the seventh month:

Nehemiah 8:18 - Also day by day, from the first day unto the last day, he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the **feast** seven days; and on the eighth day was a solemn assembly, according unto the manner.

Esther 1:3 - In the third year of his reign, he made a **feast** unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, *being* before him:

Esther 1:5 - And when these days were expired, the king made a **feast** unto all the people that were present in Shushan the palace, both unto great and small, seven days, in the court of the garden of the king's palace;

Esther 1:9 - Also Vashti the queen made a **feast** for the women *in* the royal house which *belonged* to king Ahasuerus.

Esther 2:18 - Then the king made a great **feast** unto all his princes and his servants, *even* Esther's **feast**; and he made a release to the provinces, and gave gifts, according to the state of the king.

Esther 8:17 - And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a **feast** and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell upon them.

Psalms 81:3 - Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn **feast** day.

Proverbs 15:15 - All the days of the afflicted *are* evil: but he that is of a merry heart *hath* a continual **feast**.

Ecclesiastes 10:19 - A **feast** is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all *things*.

Isaiah 25:6 - And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a **feast** of fat things, a **feast** of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined.

Lamentations 2:7 - The Lord hath cast off his altar, he hath abhorred his sanctuary, he hath given up into the hand of the enemy the walls of her palaces; they have made a noise in the house of the LORD, as in the day of a solemn **feast**.

Ezekiel 45:21 - In the first *month*, in the fourteenth day of the month, ye shall have the passover, a **feast** of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten.

Ezekiel 45:23 - And seven days of the **feast** he shall prepare a burnt offering to the LORD, seven bullocks and seven rams without blemish daily the seven days; and a kid of the goats daily *for* a sin offering.

Ezekiel 45:25 - In the seventh *month*, in the fifteenth day of the month, shall he do the like in the **feast** of the seven days, according to the sin offering, according to the burnt offering, and according to the meat offering, and according to the oil.

Daniel 5:1 - Belshazzar the king made a great **feast** to a thousand of his lords, and drank wine before the thousand.

Hosea 2:11 - I will also cause all her mirth to cease, her **feast** days, her new moons, and her sabbaths, and all her solemn feasts.

Hosea 9:5 - What will ye do in the solemn day, and in the day of the **feast** of the LORD?

Hosea 12:9 - And I *that am* the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt will yet make thee to dwell in tabernacles, as in the days of the solemn **feast**.

Amos 5:21 - I hate, I despise your **feast** days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies.

Zechariah 14:16 - And it shall come to pass, *that* every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the **feast** of tabernacles.

Zechariah 14:18 - And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that *have no rain*; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the **feast** of tabernacles.

Zechariah 14:19 - This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the **feast** of tabernacles.

Matthew 26:2 - Ye know that after two days is *the feast* of the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified.

Matthew 26:5 - But they said, Not on the **feast day**, lest there be an uproar among the people.

Matthew 26:17 - Now the first *day* of the **feast** of unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?

Matthew 27:15 - Now at *that feast* the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would.

Mark 14:1 - After two days was *the feast* of the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put *him* to death.

Mark 14:2 - But they said, Not on the **feast day**, lest there be an uproar of the people.

Mark 15:6 - Now at *that feast* he released unto them one prisoner, whomsoever they desired.

Luke 2:41 - Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the **feast** of the passover.

Luke 2:42 - And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the **feast**.

Luke 5:29 - And Levi made him a great **feast** in his own house: and there was a great company of publicans and of others that sat down with them.

Luke 14:13 - But when thou makest a **feast**, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:

Luke 22:1 - Now the **feast** of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.

Luke 23:17 - (For of necessity he must release one unto them at the **feast**.)

John 2:8 - And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the **feast**. And they bare *it*.

John 2:9 - When the ruler of the **feast** had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the **feast** called the bridegroom,

John 2:23 - Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the **feast day**, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.

John 4:45 - Then when he was come into Galilee, the Galilaeans received him, having seen all the things that he did at Jerusalem at the **feast**: for they also went unto the **feast**.

John 5:1 - **After this there was a feast of the Jews**; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

John 6:4 - And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh.

John 7:2 - Now the Jews' feast of tabernacles was at hand.

John 7:8 - Go ye up unto this **feast**: I go not up yet unto this **feast**; for my time is not yet full come.

John 7:10 - But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the **feast**, not openly, but as it were in secret.

John 7:11 - Then the Jews sought him at the **feast**, and said, Where is he?

John 7:14 - Now about the midst of the **feast** Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.

John 7:37 - In the last day, that great *day* of the **feast**, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

John 10:22 - And it was at Jerusalem the **feast** of the dedication, and it was winter.

John 11:56 - Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, What think ye, that he will not come to the **feast**?

John 12:12 - On the next day much people that were come to the **feast**, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

John 12:20 - And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the **feast**:

John 13:1 - Now before the **feast** of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.

John 13:29 - For some *of them* thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy *those things* that we have need of against the **feast**; or, that he should give something to the poor.

Acts 18:21 - But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this **feast** that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

1 Corinthians 5:8 - Therefore let us keep the **feast**, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened *bread* of sincerity and truth.

1 Corinthians 10:27 - If any of them that believe not bid you *to a feast*, and ye be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake.

2 Peter 2:13 - And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure

to riot in the day time. Spots *they are* and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they **feast** with you;

Jude 1:12 - These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they **feast** with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice.

Feasts Scripture

Leviticus 23:2 - Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, *Concerning* the **feasts** of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, *even* these *are* my **feasts**.

Leviticus 23:4 - These *are* the **feasts** of the LORD, *even* holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

Leviticus 23:37 - These *are* the **feasts** of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon his day:

Leviticus 23:44 - And Moses declared unto the children of Israel the **feasts** of the LORD.

Numbers 15:3 - And will make an offering by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, or a sacrifice in performing a vow, or in a freewill offering, or in your solemn **feasts**, to make a sweet savour unto the LORD, of the herd, or of the flock:

Numbers 29:39 - These *things* ye shall do unto the LORD in your set **feasts**, beside your vows, and your freewill offerings, for your burnt offerings, and for your meat offerings, and for your drink offerings, and for your peace offerings.

1 Chronicles 23:31 - And to offer all burnt sacrifices unto the LORD in the sabbaths, in the new moons, and on the set **feasts**, by number, according to the order commanded unto them, continually before the LORD:

2 Chronicles 2:4 - Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate *it* to him, *and* to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn **feasts** of the LORD our God. This *is an ordinance* for ever to Israel.

2 Chronicles 8:13 - Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn **feasts**, three times in the year, *even* in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles.

2 Chronicles 31:3 - *He appointed* also the king's portion of his substance for the burnt offerings, *to wit*, for the morning and evening burnt offerings, and the burnt offerings for the sabbaths, and for the new moons, and for the set **feasts**, as *it is* written in the law of the LORD.

Ezra 3:5 - And afterward *offered* the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of all the set **feasts** of the LORD that were consecrated, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.

Nehemiah 10:33 - For the shewbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set **feasts**, and for the holy *things*, and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and *for* all the work of the house of our God.

Psalms 35:16 - With hypocritical mockers in **feasts**, they gnashed upon me with their teeth.

Isaiah 1:14 - **Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth**: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear *them*.

Isaiah 5:12 - And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their **feasts**: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.

Jeremiah 51:39 - In their heat I will make their **feasts**, and I will make them drunken, that they may rejoice, and sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the LORD.

Lamentations 1:4 - The ways of Zion do mourn, because none come to the solemn **feasts**: all her gates are desolate: her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she *is* in bitterness.

Lamentations 2:6 - And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as *if it were* of a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn **feasts** and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

Ezekiel 36:38 - As the holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn **feasts**; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Ezekiel 45:17 - And it shall be the prince's part *to give* burnt offerings, and meat offerings, and drink offerings, in the **feasts**, and in the new moons, and in the sabbaths, in all solemnities of the house of Israel: he shall prepare the sin offering, and the meat offering, and the burnt offering, and the peace offerings, to make reconciliation for the house of Israel.

Ezekiel 46:9 - But when the people of the land shall come before the LORD in the solemn **feasts**, he that entereth in by the way of the north gate to worship shall go out by the way of the south gate; and he that entereth by the way of the south gate shall go forth by the way of the north gate: he shall not return by the way of the gate whereby he came in, but shall go forth over against it.

Ezekiel 46:11 - And in the **feasts** and in the solemnities the meat offering shall be an ephah to a bullock, and an ephah to a ram, and to the lambs as he is able to give, and an hin of oil to an ephah.

Hosea 2:11 - I will also cause all her mirth to cease, her feast days, her new moons, and her sabbaths, and all her solemn **feasts**.

Amos 8:10 - And I will turn your **feasts** into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only *son*, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

Nahum 1:15 - Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn **feasts**, perform thy vows: for the wicked shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off.

Zechariah 8:19 - Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth *month*, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful **feasts**; therefore love the truth and peace.

Malachi 2:3 - Behold, I will corrupt your seed, and spread dung upon your faces, *even* the dung of your solemn **feasts**; and *one* shall take you away with it.

Matthew 23:6 - And love the uppermost rooms at **feasts**, and the chief seats in the synagogues,

Mark 12:39 - And the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at **feasts**:

Luke 20:46 - Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at **feasts**;

Jude 1:12 - These are spots in your **feasts** of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose

Judgments Scripture

Exodus 6:6 - Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I *am* the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great **judgments**:

Exodus 7:4 - But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, *and* my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great **judgments**.

Exodus 21:1 - Now these *are* the **judgments** which thou shalt set before them.

Exodus 24:3 - And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the **judgments**: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD hath said will we do.

Leviticus 18:4 - Ye shall do my **judgments**, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I *am* the LORD your God.

Leviticus 18:5 - Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my **judgments**: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 18:26 - Ye shall therefore keep my statutes and my **judgments**, and shall not commit *any* of these abominations; *neither* any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you:

Leviticus 19:37 - Therefore shall ye observe all my statutes, and all my **judgments**, and do them: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 20:22 - Ye shall therefore keep all my statutes, and all my **judgments**, and do them: that the land, whither I bring you to dwell therein, spue you not out.

Leviticus 25:18 - Wherefore ye shall do my statutes, and keep my **judgments**, and do them; and ye shall dwell in the land in safety.

Leviticus 26:15 - And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my **judgments**, so that ye will not do all my commandments, *but* that ye break my covenant:

Leviticus 26:43 - The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my **judgments**, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

Leviticus 26:46 - These *are* the statutes and **judgments** and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.

Numbers 33:4 - For the Egyptians buried all *their* firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed **judgments**.

Numbers 35:24 - Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these **judgments**:

Numbers 36:13 - These *are* the commandments and the **judgments**, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.

Deuteronomy 4:1 - Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the **judgments**, which I teach you, for to do *them*, that ye may live, and go in and possess the

land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you.

Deuteronomy 4:5 - Behold, I have taught you statutes and **judgments**, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:8 - And what nation *is there* so great, that hath statutes and **judgments** so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 4:14 - And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and **judgments**, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:45 - These *are* the testimonies, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt,

Deuteronomy 5:1 - And Moses called all Israel, and said unto them, Hear, O Israel, the statutes and **judgments** which I speak in your ears this day, that ye may learn them, and keep, and do them.

Deuteronomy 5:31 - But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the commandments, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

Deuteronomy 6:1 - Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the **judgments**, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

Deuteronomy 6:20 - *And* when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What *mean* the testimonies, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which the LORD our God hath commanded you?

Deuteronomy 7:11 - Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which I command thee this day, to do them.

Deuteronomy 7:12 - Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these **judgments**, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the mercy which he sware unto thy fathers:

Deuteronomy 8:11 - Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his **judgments**, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

Deuteronomy 11:1 - Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his **judgments**, and his commandments, always.

Deuteronomy 11:32 - And ye shall observe to do all the statutes and **judgments** which I set before you this day.

Deuteronomy 12:1 - These *are* the statutes and **judgments**, which ye shall observe to do in

the land, which the LORD God of thy fathers giveth thee to possess it, all the days that ye live upon the earth.

Deuteronomy 26:16 - This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these statutes and **judgments**: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

Deuteronomy 26:17 - Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his **judgments**, and to hearken unto his voice:

Deuteronomy 30:16 - In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his **judgments**, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deuteronomy 33:10 - They shall teach Jacob thy **judgments**, and Israel thy law: they shall put incense before thee, and whole burnt sacrifice upon thine altar.

Deuteronomy 33:21 - And he provided the first part for himself, because there, *in* a portion of the lawgiver, *was he* seated; and he came with the heads of the people, he executed the justice of the LORD, and his **judgments** with Israel.

2 Samuel 22:23 - For all his **judgments** *were* before me: and *as for* his statutes, I did not depart from them.

1 Kings 2:3 - And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his **judgments**, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

1 Kings 6:12 - *Concerning* this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my **judgments**, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

1 Kings 8:58 - That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his statutes, and his **judgments**, which he commanded our fathers.

1 Kings 9:4 - And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, *and* wilt keep my statutes and my **judgments**:

1 Kings 11:33 - Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do *that which is* right in mine eyes, and *to keep* my statutes and my **judgments**, as *did* David his father.

1 Chronicles 16:12 - Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the **judgments** of his mouth;

1 Chronicles 16:14 - He *is* the LORD our God; his **judgments** *are* in all the earth.

1 Chronicles 22:13 - Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and **judgments** which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

1 Chronicles 28:7 - Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my **judgments**, as at this day.

2 Chronicles 7:17 - And as for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my statutes and my **judgments**;

2 Chronicles 19:10 - And what cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and **judgments**, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and ye shall not trespass.

Ezra 7:10 - For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and **judgments**.

Nehemiah 1:7 - We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the **judgments**, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

Nehemiah 9:13 - Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right **judgments**, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

Nehemiah 9:29 - And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy **judgments**, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

Nehemiah 10:29 - They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and his **judgments** and his statutes;

Psalms 10:5 - His ways are always grievous; thy **judgments** *are* far above out of his sight: as *for* all his enemies, he puffeth at them.

Psalms 18:22 - For all his **judgments** *were* before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me.

Psalm 19:9 - The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring for ever: the **judgments** of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.

Psalm 36:6 - Thy righteousness *is* like the great mountains; thy **judgments** *are* a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

Psalm 48:11 - Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy **judgments**.

Psalm 72:1 - Give the king thy **judgments**, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

Psalm 89:30 - If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my **judgments**;

Psalm 97:8 - Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy **judgments**, O LORD.

Psalm 105:5 - Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the **judgments** of his mouth;

Psalm 105:7 - He *is* the LORD our God: his **judgments** *are* in all the earth.

Psalm 119:7 - I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous **judgments**.

Psalm 119:13 - With my lips have I declared all the **judgments** of thy mouth.

Psalm 119:20 - My soul breaketh for the longing *that it hath* unto thy **judgments** at all times.

Psalm 119:30 - I have chosen the way of truth: thy **judgments** have I laid *before me*.

Psalm 119:39 - Turn away my reproach which I fear: for thy **judgments** *are* good.

Psalm 119:43 - And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in thy **judgments**.

Psalm 119:52 - I remembered thy **judgments** of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.

Psalm 119:62 - At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous **judgments**.

Psalm 119:75 - I know, O LORD, that thy **judgments** *are* right, and *that* thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me.

Psalm 119:102 - I have not departed from thy **judgments**: for thou hast taught me.

Psalm 119:106 - I have sworn, and I will perform *it*, that I will keep thy righteous **judgments**.

Psalm 119:108 - Accept, I beseech thee, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy **judgments**.

Psalm 119:120 - My flesh trembleth for fear of thee; and I am afraid of thy **judgments**.

Psalm 119:137 - Righteous *art* thou, O LORD, and upright *are* thy **judgments**.

Psalm 119:156 - Great *are* thy tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to thy **judgments**.

Psalm 119:160 - Thy word *is* true *from* the beginning: and every one of thy righteous **judgments** *endureth* for ever.

Psalm 119:164 - Seven times a day do I praise thee because of thy righteous **judgments**.

Psalm 119:175 - Let my soul live, and it shall praise thee; and let thy **judgments** help me.

Psalm 147:19 - He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his **judgments** unto Israel.

Psalm 147:20 - He hath not dealt so with any nation: and *as for his* **judgments**, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD.

Proverbs 19:29 - **Judgments** are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools.

Isaiah 26:8 - Yea, in the way of thy **judgments**, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of *our* soul *is* to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee.

Isaiah 26:9 - With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy **judgments** *are* in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

Jeremiah 1:16 - And I will utter my **judgments** against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshipped the works of their own hands.

Jeremiah 12:1 - Righteous *art* thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of *thy* **judgments**: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? *wherefore* are all they happy that deal very treacherously?

Ezekiel 5:6 - And she hath changed my **judgments** into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that *are* round about her: for they have refused my **judgments** and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

Ezekiel 5:7 - Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye multiplied more than the nations that *are* round about you, *and* have not walked in my statutes, neither have kept my **judgments**, neither have done according to the **judgments** of the nations that *are* round about you;

Ezekiel 5:8 - Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, *am* against thee, and will execute **judgments** in the midst of thee in the sight of the nations.

Ezekiel 5:10 - Therefore the fathers shall eat the sons in the midst of thee, and the sons shall eat their fathers; and I will execute **judgments** in thee, and the whole remnant of thee will I scatter into all the winds.

Ezekiel 5:15 - So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that *are* round about thee, when I shall execute **judgments** in thee in anger and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken *it*.

Ezekiel 11:9 - And I will bring you out of the midst thereof, and deliver you into the hands of strangers, and will execute **judgments** among you.

Ezekiel 11:12 - And ye shall know that I *am* the LORD: for ye have not walked in my statutes, neither executed my **judgments**, but have done after the manners of the heathen that *are* round about you.

Ezekiel 14:21 - For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore **judgments** upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?

Ezekiel 16:41 - And they shall burn thine houses with fire, and execute **judgments** upon thee in the sight of many women: and I will cause thee to cease from playing the harlot, and thou also shalt give no hire any more.

Ezekiel 18:9 - Hath walked in my statutes, and hath kept my **judgments**, to deal truly; he *is* just, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 18:17 - *That* hath taken off his hand from the poor, *that* hath not received usury nor increase, hath executed my **judgments**, hath walked in my statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live.

Ezekiel 20:11 - And I gave them my statutes, and shewed them my **judgments**, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them.

Ezekiel 20:13 - But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness: they walked not in my statutes, and they despised my **judgments**, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; and my sabbaths they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them.

Ezekiel 20:16 - Because they despised my **judgments**, and walked not in my statutes, but polluted my sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols.

Ezekiel 20:18 - But I said unto their children in the wilderness, Walk ye not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their **judgments**, nor defile yourselves with their idols:

Ezekiel 20:19 - I *am* the LORD your God; walk in my statutes, and keep my **judgments**, and do them;

Ezekiel 20:21 - Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my **judgments** to do them, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

Ezekiel 20:24 - Because they had not executed my **judgments**, but had despised my statutes, and had polluted my sabbaths, and their eyes were after their fathers' idols.

Ezekiel 20:25 - Wherefore I gave them also statutes *that were* not good, and **judgments** whereby they should not live;

Ezekiel 23:24 - And they shall come against thee with chariots, wagons, and wheels, and with an assembly of people, *which* shall set against thee buckler and shield and helmet round about: and I will set judgment before them, and they shall judge thee according to their **judgments**.

Ezekiel 25:11 - And I will execute **judgments** upon Moab; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Ezekiel 28:22 - And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against thee, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of thee: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I shall have executed **judgments** in her, and shall be sanctified in her.

Ezekiel 28:26 - And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed **judgments** upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD their God.

Ezekiel 30:14 - And I will make Pathros desolate, and will set fire in Zoan, and will execute **judgments** in No.

Ezekiel 30:19 - Thus will I execute **judgments** in Egypt: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Ezekiel 36:27 - And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my **judgments**, and do *them*.

Ezekiel 37:24 - And David my servant *shall be* king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my **judgments**, and observe my statutes, and do them.

Ezekiel 44:24 - And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; *and* they shall judge it according to my **judgments**: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths.

Daniel 9:5 - We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy **judgments**:

Hosea 6:5 - Therefore have I hewed *them* by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth: and thy **judgments** *are as* the light *that* goeth forth.

Zephaniah 3:15 - The LORD hath taken away thy **judgments**, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, *even* the LORD, *is* in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more.

Malachi 4:4 - Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with* the statutes and **judgments**.

Romans 11:33 - O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable *are* his **judgments**, and his ways past finding out!

1 Corinthians 6:4 - If then ye have **judgments** of things pertaining to this life, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church.

Revelation 15:4 - Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for *thou* only *art* holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy **judgments** are made manifest.

Revelation 16:7 - And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous *are* thy **judgments**.

Revelation 19:2 - For true and righteous *are* his **judgments**: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

Ordinance Scripture

Exodus 12:14 - And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and **ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.**

Exodus 12:17 - And ye shall observe *the feast of* unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an **ordinance** for ever.

Exodus 12:24 - And ye shall observe this thing for an **ordinance** to thee and to thy sons for ever.

Exodus 12:43 - And the LORD said unto Moses and Aaron, This *is* the **ordinance** of the passover: There shall no stranger eat thereof:

Exodus 13:10 - Thou shalt therefore keep this **ordinance** in his season from year to year.

Exodus 15:25 - And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, *which* when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an **ordinance**, and there he proved them,

Leviticus 18:30 - Therefore shall ye keep mine **ordinance**, that ye commit not *any one* of these abominable customs, which were committed before you, and that ye defile not yourselves therein: I *am* the LORD your God.

Leviticus 22:9 - They shall therefore keep mine **ordinance**, lest they bear sin for it, and die therefore, if they profane it: I the LORD do sanctify them.

Numbers 9:14 - And if a stranger shall sojourn among you, and will keep the passover unto the LORD; according to the **ordinance** of the passover, and according to the manner thereof, so shall he do: ye shall have one **ordinance**, both for the stranger, and for him that was born in the land.

Numbers 10:8 - And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow with the trumpets; and they shall be to you for an **ordinance** for ever throughout your generations.

Numbers 15:15 - One **ordinance** *shall be both* for you of the congregation, and also for the stranger that sojourneth *with you*, an **ordinance** for ever in your generations: as ye *are*, so shall the stranger be before the LORD.

Numbers 18:8 - And the LORD spake unto Aaron, Behold, I also have given thee the charge of mine heave offerings of all the hallowed things of the children of Israel; unto thee have I given them by reason of the anointing, and to thy sons, by an **ordinance** for ever.

Numbers 19:2 - This *is* the **ordinance** of the law which the LORD hath commanded, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring thee a red heifer without spot, wherein *is* no blemish, *and* upon which never came yoke:

Numbers 31:21 - And Eleazar the priest said unto the men of war which went to the battle, This *is* the **ordinance** of the law which the LORD commanded Moses;

Joshua 24:25 - So Joshua made a covenant with the people that day, and set them a statute and an **ordinance** in Shechem.

1 Samuel 30:25 - And it was so from that day forward, that he made it a statute and an **ordinance** for Israel unto this day.

2 Chronicles 2:4 - Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate *it* to him, *and* to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts of the LORD our God. **This is an ordinance for ever to Israel.**

2 Chronicles 35:13 - And they roasted the passover with fire according to the **ordinance**: but the *other holy offerings* sod they in pots, and in caldrons, and in pans, and divided *them* speedily among all the people.

2 Chronicles 35:25 - And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah: and all the singing men and the singing women spake of Josiah in their lamentations to this day, and made them an **ordinance** in Israel: and, behold, they *are* written in the lamentations.

Ezra 3:10 - And when the builders laid the foundation of the temple of the LORD, they set the priests in their apparel with trumpets, and the Levites the sons of Asaph with cymbals, to praise the LORD, after the **ordinance** of David king of Israel.

Psalms 99:7 - He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar: they kept his testimonies, **and the ordinance that he gave them.**

Isaiah 24:5 - The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the **ordinance**, broken the everlasting covenant.

Isaiah 58:2 - Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know my ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the **ordinance** of their God: they ask of me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God.

Ezekiel 45:14 - Concerning the **ordinance** of oil, the bath of oil, *ye shall offer* the tenth part of a bath out of the cor, *which is* an homer of ten baths; for ten baths *are* an homer:

Ezekiel 46:14 - And thou shalt prepare a meat offering for it every morning, the sixth part of an ephah, and the third part of an hin of oil, to temper with the fine flour; a meat offering continually by a perpetual **ordinance** unto the LORD.

Malachi 3:14 - Ye have said, It *is* vain to serve God: and what profit *is it* that we have kept his **ordinance**, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts?

Romans 13:2 - Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the **ordinance** of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

1 Peter 2:13 - Submit yourselves to every **ordinance** of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme;

Ordinances Scripture

Exodus 18:20 - And thou shalt teach them **ordinances** and laws, and shalt shew them the way wherein they must walk, and the work that they must do.

Leviticus 18:3 - After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their **ordinances**.

Leviticus 18:4 - Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine **ordinances**, to walk therein: I *am* the LORD your God.

Numbers 9:12 - They shall leave none of it unto the morning, nor break any bone of it: according to all the **ordinances** of the passover they shall keep it.

2 Kings 17:34 - Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their **ordinances**, or after the law and commandment **which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;**

2 Kings 17:37 - And the statutes, and the **ordinances**, and the law, and the commandment, which he wrote for you, ye shall observe to do for evermore; and ye shall not fear other gods.

2 Chronicles 33:8 - Neither will I any more remove the foot of Israel from out of the land which I have appointed for your fathers; so that they will take heed to do all that I have commanded them, according to the whole law and the statutes and the **ordinances** by the hand of Moses.

Nehemiah 10:32 - Also we made **ordinances** for us, to charge ourselves yearly with the third part of a shekel for the service of the house of our God;

Job 38:33 - Knowest thou the **ordinances** of heaven? canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth?

Psalms 119:91 - They continue this day according to thine **ordinances**: for all *are* thy servants.

Isaiah 58:2 - Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know my ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of me the **ordinances** of justice; they take delight in approaching to God.

Jeremiah 31:35 - Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for a light by day, *and* the **ordinances** of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar; The LORD of hosts *is* his name:

Jeremiah 31:36 - If those **ordinances** depart from before me, saith the LORD, *then* the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever.

Jeremiah 33:25 - Thus saith the LORD; If my covenant *be* not with day and night, *and if* I have not appointed the **ordinances** of heaven and earth;

Ezekiel 11:20 - That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine **ordinances**, and do them:

and they shall be my people, and I will be their God. (O house of Israel – see verses 5-19)

Ezekiel 43:11 - And if they be ashamed of all that they have done, shew them the form of the house, and the fashion thereof, and the goings out thereof, and the comings in thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the **ordinances** thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the laws thereof: and write *it* in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof, and all the **ordinances** thereof, and do them.

Ezekiel 43:18 - And he said unto me, Son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD; These *are* the **ordinances** of the altar in the day when they shall make it, to offer burnt offerings thereon, and to sprinkle blood thereon.

Ezekiel 44:5 - And the LORD said unto me, Son of man, mark well, and behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears all that I say unto thee concerning all the **ordinances** of the house of the LORD, and all the laws thereof; and mark well the entering in of the house, with every going forth of the sanctuary.

Malachi 3:7 - Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine **ordinances**, and have not kept *them*. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the LORD of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return?

Luke 1:6 - And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and **ordinances** of the Lord blameless.

1 Corinthians 11:2 - Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the **ordinances**, as I delivered *them* to you.

Ephesians 2:15 - Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in **ordinances**; for to make in himself of twain one new man, *so* making peace;

Colossians 2:14 - Blotting out the handwriting of **ordinances** that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Colossians 2:20 - Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to **ordinances**,

Hebrews 9:1 - Then verily the first *covenant* had also **ordinances** of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary.

Hebrews 9:10 - *Which stood* only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal **ordinances**, imposed *on them* until the time of reformation.

Precepts Scripture

Nehemiah 9:14 - And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them **precepts**, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

Psalm 119:4 - Thou hast commanded us to keep thy **precepts** diligently.

Psalm 119:15 - I will meditate in thy **precepts**, and have respect unto thy ways.

Psalm 119:27 - Make me to understand the way of thy **precepts**: so shall I talk of thy wondrous works.

Psalm 119:40 - Behold, I have longed after thy **precepts**: quicken me in thy righteousness.

Psalm 119:45 - And I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:56 - This I had, because I kept thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:63 - I am a companion of all them that fear thee, and of them that keep thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:69 - The proud have forged a lie against me: but I will keep thy **precepts** with my whole heart.

Psalm 119:78 - Let the proud be ashamed; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: but I will meditate in thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:87 - They had almost consumed me upon earth; but I forsook not thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:93 - I will never forget thy **precepts**: for with them thou hast quickened me.

Psalm 119:94 - I am thine, save me; for I have sought thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:100 - I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:104 - Through thy **precepts** I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.

Psalm 119:110 - The wicked have laid a snare for me: yet I erred not from thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:128 - Therefore I esteem all thy **precepts** concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way.

Psalm 119:134 - Deliver me from the oppression of man: so will I keep thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:141 - I am small and despised: yet do not I forget thy **precepts**.

Psalm 119:159 - Consider how I love thy **precepts**: quicken me, O LORD, according to thy lovingkindness.

Psalm 119:168 - I have kept thy **precepts** and thy testimonies: for all my ways are before thee.

Psalm 119:173 - Let thine hand help me; for I have chosen thy **precepts**.

Jeremiah 35:18 - And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his **precepts**, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you:

Daniel 9:5 - We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy **precepts** and from thy judgments:

Statutes Scripture

Genesis 26:5 - Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my **statutes**, and my laws.

Exodus 15:26 - And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his **statutes**, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

Exodus 18:16 - When they have a matter, they come unto me; and I judge between one and another, and I do make *them* know the **statutes** of God, and his laws.

Leviticus 10:11 - And that ye may teach the children of Israel all the **statutes** which the LORD hath spoken unto them by the hand of Moses.

Leviticus 18:5 - Ye shall therefore keep my **statutes**, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 18:26 - Ye shall therefore keep my **statutes** and my judgments, and shall not commit *any* of these abominations; *neither* any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you:

Leviticus 19:19 - Ye shall keep my **statutes**. Thou shalt not let thy cattle gender with a diverse kind: thou shalt not sow thy field with mingled seed: neither shall a garment mingled of linen and woollen come upon thee.

Leviticus 19:37 - Therefore shall ye observe all my **statutes**, and all my judgments, and do them: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 20:8 - And ye shall keep my **statutes**, and do them: I *am* the LORD which sanctify you.

Leviticus 20:22 - Ye shall therefore keep all my **statutes**, and all my judgments, and do them: that the land, whither I bring you to dwell therein, spue you not out.

Leviticus 25:18 - Wherefore ye shall do my **statutes**, and keep my judgments, and do them; and ye shall dwell in the land in safety.

Leviticus 26:3 - If ye walk in my **statutes**, and keep my commandments, and do them;

Leviticus 26:15 - And if ye shall despise my **statutes**, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, *but* that ye break my covenant:

Leviticus 26:43 - The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my **statutes**.

Leviticus 26:46 - These *are* the **statutes** and judgments and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.

Numbers 30:16 - These *are* the **statutes**, which the LORD commanded Moses, between a man and his wife, between the father and his daughter, *being yet* in her youth in her father's house.

Deuteronomy 4:1 - Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the **statutes** and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do *them*, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you.

Deuteronomy 4:5 - Behold, I have taught you **statutes** and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:6 - Keep therefore and do *them*; for this *is* your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these **statutes**, and say, Surely this great nation *is* a wise and understanding people.

Deuteronomy 4:8 - And what nation *is there* so great, that hath **statutes** and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 4:14 - And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you **statutes** and judgments, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:40 - Thou shalt keep therefore his **statutes**, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that

thou mayest prolong *thy* days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.

Deuteronomy 4:45 - These *are* the testimonies, and the **statutes**, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt,

Deuteronomy 5:1 - And Moses called all Israel, and said unto them, Hear, **O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your ears this day, that ye may learn them, and keep, and do them.**

Deuteronomy 5:31 - But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the commandments, and the **statutes**, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

Deuteronomy 6:1 - Now these *are* the commandments, the **statutes**, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

Deuteronomy 6:2 - That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his **statutes** and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

Deuteronomy 6:17 - Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his **statutes**, which he hath commanded thee.

Deuteronomy 6:20 - *And* when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What *mean* the testimonies, and the **statutes**, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you?

Deuteronomy 6:24 - And the LORD commanded us to do all these **statutes**, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as *it is* at this day.

Deuteronomy 7:11 - Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the **statutes**, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

Deuteronomy 8:11 - Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his **statutes**, which I command thee this day:

Deuteronomy 10:13 - To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his **statutes**, which I command thee this day for thy good?

Deuteronomy 11:1 - Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge, and his **statutes**, and his judgments, and his commandments, *always*.

Deuteronomy 11:32 - And ye shall observe to do all the **statutes** and judgments which I set before you this day.

Deuteronomy 12:1 - These *are* the **statutes** and judgments, which ye shall observe to do in

the land, which the LORD God of thy fathers giveth thee to possess it, all the days that ye live upon the earth.

Deuteronomy 16:12 - And thou shalt remember that thou wast a bondman in Egypt: and thou shalt observe and do these **statutes**.

Deuteronomy 17:19 - And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these **statutes**, to do them:

Deuteronomy 26:16 - This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these **statutes** and judgments: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

Deuteronomy 26:17 - Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his **statutes**, and his commandments, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:

Deuteronomy 27:10 - Thou shalt therefore obey the voice of the LORD thy God, and do his commandments and his **statutes**, which I command thee this day.

Deuteronomy 28:15 - But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his **statutes** which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Deuteronomy 28:45 - Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his **statutes** which he commanded thee:

Deuteronomy 30:10 - If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his **statutes** which are written in this book of the law, *and* if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

Deuteronomy 30:16 - In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his **statutes** and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

2 Samuel 22:23 - For all his judgments *were* before me: and *as for* his **statutes**, I did not depart from them.

1 Kings 2:3 - And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his **judgments**, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

1 Kings 3:3 - And Solomon loved the LORD, walking in the **statutes** of David his father: only he sacrificed and burnt incense in high places.

1 Kings 3:14 - And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my **statutes** and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

1 Kings 6:12 - *Concerning* this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my **statutes**, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

1 Kings 8:58 - That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his **statutes**, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.

1 Kings 8:61 - Let your heart therefore be perfect with the LORD our God, to walk in his **statutes**, and to keep his commandments, as at this day.

1 Kings 9:4 - And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, *and* wilt keep my **statutes** and my judgments:

1 Kings 9:6 - *But* if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your children, and will not keep my commandments *and* my **statutes** which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them:

1 Kings 11:11 - Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my **statutes**, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.

1 Kings 11:33 - Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do *that which is* right in mine eyes, and *to keep* my **statutes** and my judgments, as *did* David his father.

1 Kings 11:34 - Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my **statutes**:

1 Kings 11:38 - And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do *that is* right in my sight, to keep my **statutes** and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

2 Kings 17:8 - And walked in the **statutes** of the heathen, whom the LORD cast out from before the children of Israel, and of the kings of Israel, which they had made.

2 Kings 17:13 - Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, *and by* all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments *and*

my **statutes**, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

2 Kings 17:15 - And they rejected his **statutes**, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his testimonies which he testified against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that *were* round about them, *concerning* whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them.

2 Kings 17:19 - Also Judah kept not the commandments of the LORD their God, but walked in the **statutes** of Israel which they made.

2 Kings 17:34 - Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their **statutes**, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;

2 Kings 17:37 - And the **statutes**, and the ordinances, and the law, and the commandment, which he wrote for you, ye shall observe to do for evermore; and ye shall not fear other gods.

2 Kings 23:3 - And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his **statutes** with all *their* heart and all *their* soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

1 Chronicles 22:13 - Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the **statutes** and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

1 Chronicles 29:19 - And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy commandments, thy testimonies, and thy **statutes**, and to do all *these things*, and to build the palace, *for* the which I have made provision.

2 Chronicles 7:17 - And as for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my **statutes** and my judgments;

2 Chronicles 7:19 - But if ye turn away, and forsake my **statutes** and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them;

2 Chronicles 19:10 - And what cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, **statutes** and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and ye shall not trespass.

2 Chronicles 33:8 - Neither will I any more remove the foot of Israel from out of the land which I have appointed for your fathers; so that they will take heed to do all that I have commanded them, according to the whole law and the **statutes** and the ordinances by the hand of Moses.

2 Chronicles 34:31 - And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments, and his testimonies, and his **statutes**, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

Ezra 7:10 - For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel **statutes** and judgments.

Ezra 7:11 - Now this *is* the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, *even* a scribe of the words of the commandments of the LORD, and of his **statutes** to Israel.

Nehemiah 1:7 - We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the **statutes**, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

Nehemiah 9:13 - Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good **statutes** and commandments:

Nehemiah 9:14 - And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them precepts, **statutes**, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

Nehemiah 10:29 - They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his **statutes**;

Psalms 18:22 - For all his judgments *were* before me, and I did not put away his **statutes** from me.

Psalms 19:8 - The **statutes** of the LORD *are* right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD *is* pure, enlightening the eyes.

Psalms 50:16 - But unto the wicked God saith, What hast thou to do to declare my **statutes**, or *that* thou shouldst take my covenant in thy mouth?

Psalms 89:31 - If they break my **statutes**, and keep not my commandments;

Psalms 105:45 - That they might observe his **statutes**, and keep his laws. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalms 119:5 - O that my ways were directed to keep thy **statutes**!

Psalms 119:8 - I will keep thy **statutes**: O forsake me not utterly.

Psalms 119:12 - Blessed *art* thou, O LORD: teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:16 - I will delight myself in thy **statutes**: I will not forget thy word.

Psalm 119:23 - Princes also did sit *and* speak against me: *but* thy servant did meditate in thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:26 - I have declared my ways, and thou heardest me: teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:33 - Teach me, O LORD, the way of thy **statutes**; and I shall keep it *unto* the end.

Psalm 119:48 - My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:54 - Thy **statutes** have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage.

Psalm 119:64 - The earth, O LORD, is full of thy mercy: teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:68 - Thou *art* good, and doest good; teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:71 - *It is* good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:80 - Let my heart be sound in thy **statutes**; that I be not ashamed.

Psalm 119:83 - For I am become like a bottle in the smoke; *yet* do I not forget thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:112 - I have inclined mine heart to perform thy **statutes** *always, even unto* the end.

Psalm 119:117 - Hold thou me up, and I shall be safe: and I will have respect unto thy **statutes** continually.

Psalm 119:118 - Thou hast trodden down all them that err from thy **statutes**: for their deceit *is* falsehood.

Psalm 119:124 - Deal with thy servant according unto thy mercy, and teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:135 - Make thy face to shine upon thy servant; and teach me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:145 - I cried with *my* whole heart; hear me, O LORD: I will keep thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:155 - Salvation *is* far from the wicked: for they seek not thy **statutes**.

Psalm 119:171 - My lips shall utter praise, when thou hast taught me thy **statutes**.

Psalm 147:19 - He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his **statutes** and his judgments unto Israel.

Jeremiah 44:10 - They are not humbled *even* unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my **statutes**, that I set before you and before your fathers.

Jeremiah 44:23 - Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his **statutes**, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day.

Ezekiel 5:6 - And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my **statutes** more than the countries that *are* round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my **statutes**, they have not walked in them.

Ezekiel 5:7 - Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye multiplied more than the nations that *are* round about you, *and* have not walked in my **statutes**, neither have kept my judgments, neither have done according to the judgments of the nations that *are* round about you;

Ezekiel 11:12 - And ye shall know that I *am* the LORD: for ye have not walked in my **statutes**, neither executed my judgments, but have done after the manners of the heathen that *are* round about you.

Ezekiel 11:20 - That they may walk in my **statutes**, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Ezekiel 18:9 - Hath walked in my **statutes**, and hath kept my judgments, to deal truly; he *is* just, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 18:17 - *That* hath taken off his hand from the poor, *that* hath not received usury nor increase, hath executed my judgments, hath walked in my **statutes**; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live.

Ezekiel 18:19 - Yet say ye, Why? doth not the son bear the iniquity of the father? When the son hath done that which is lawful and right, *and* hath kept all my **statutes**, and hath done them, he shall surely live.

Ezekiel 18:21 - But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my **statutes**, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezekiel 20:11 - And I gave them my **statutes**, and shewed them my judgments, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them.

Ezekiel 20:13 - But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness: they walked not in my **statutes**, and they despised my judgments, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; and my sabbaths they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them.

Ezekiel 20:16 - Because they despised my judgments, and walked not in my **statutes**, but polluted my sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols.

Ezekiel 20:18 - But I said unto their children in the wilderness, Walk ye not in the **statutes** of your fathers, neither observe their judgments, nor defile yourselves with their idols:

Ezekiel 20:19 - I *am* the LORD your God; walk in my **statutes**, and keep my judgments, and do them;

Ezekiel 20:21 - Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my **statutes**, neither kept my judgments to do them, which *if* a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

Ezekiel 20:24 - Because they had not executed my judgments, but had despised my **statutes**, and had polluted my sabbaths, and their eyes were after their fathers' idols.

Ezekiel 20:25 - Wherefore I gave them also **statutes** *that were* not good, and judgments whereby they should not live;

Ezekiel 33:15 - *If* the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the **statutes** of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezekiel 36:27 - And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my **statutes**, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*.

Ezekiel 37:24 - And David my servant *shall be* king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my **statutes**, and do them.

Ezekiel 44:24 - And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; *and* they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my **statutes** in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths.

Micah 6:16 - For the **statutes** of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.

Zechariah 1:6 - But my words and my **statutes**, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as the LORD of hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so hath he dealt with us.

Malachi 4:4 - Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with* the **statutes** and judgments.
